The Banksia Grove development has launched a new contemporary urban living precinct called Coda.

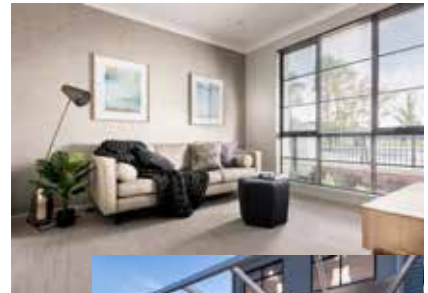
Coda will contain a selection of upmarket terraces and apartments all within walking distance to the Banksia Grove town centre shopping precinct.

Next term we will start to explore some of these ideas and also take a look at the big picture of Books of the Bible - their background, context, key characters, themes and relevance today.

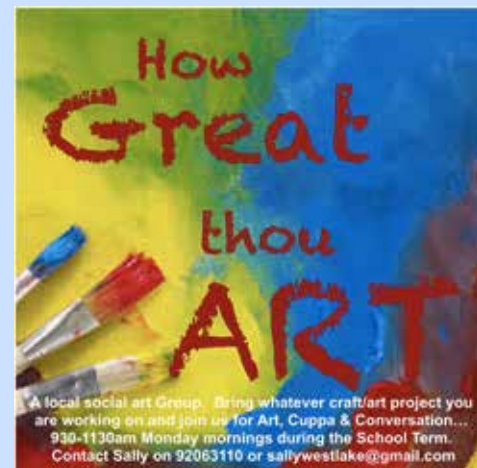


Cheers Family Camp

GOODSTART BANKSIA GROVE A LEADING LIGHT FOR FAMILY CONNECTIONS

Goodstart Banksia Grove is taking a lead role in a program supporting early learning centres to improve childhood outcomes, build family relationships and connect with community.

Family Connections is a program aimed at supporting family relationships and building connections with community services.

Goodstart Banksia Grove completed the Family Connections program in 2016 and Centre Director Lynne Scotland is returning to mentor new centres taking part in the program in 2018.

"This program really does make a difference to our educators, families and communities. Our educators have learnt so much through this – empathy and understanding of children's behaviour. The best part of the program is that by running community programs, we can also help families throughout the community rather than just those at our centre." Mrs Scotland said.

Goodstart's Family Connections is a unique program for centre directors and educators to improve outcomes for children and their families - particularly those in vulnerable circumstances.

In Western Australia, the program is supported by the Woodside Development Fund and in 2018, has been offered to 20 early learning centres both in and outside of Goodstart.

"The program is like a missing link for us ... We knew we could do more in the community but we just weren't sure how to do it. When we began to see the results, it was amazing."

The centre now has built great relationships with local schools, child and parent centre and community networks.

"The centre has gone from strength to strength ... and when I received an email about mentoring the program at other centres, I jumped at the chance. "Rather than saying children have behavioural issues, we now talk about their unmet needs and how we can help them feel more secure." Mrs Scotland said.

Goodstart Early Learning Western Australia state manager Todd Dawson said the program enhanced educational programs and practices across child care services for the ultimate benefit of children and their families.

"We know children who are vulnerable benefit most from early learning experiences, but often participate the least. This is why we work to ensure all children – regardless of their circumstances – have access to high quality early learning programs." For more information visit www.goodstart.org.au.

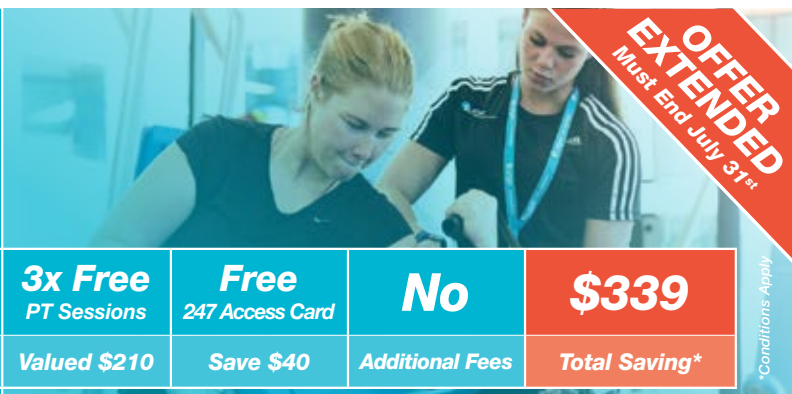

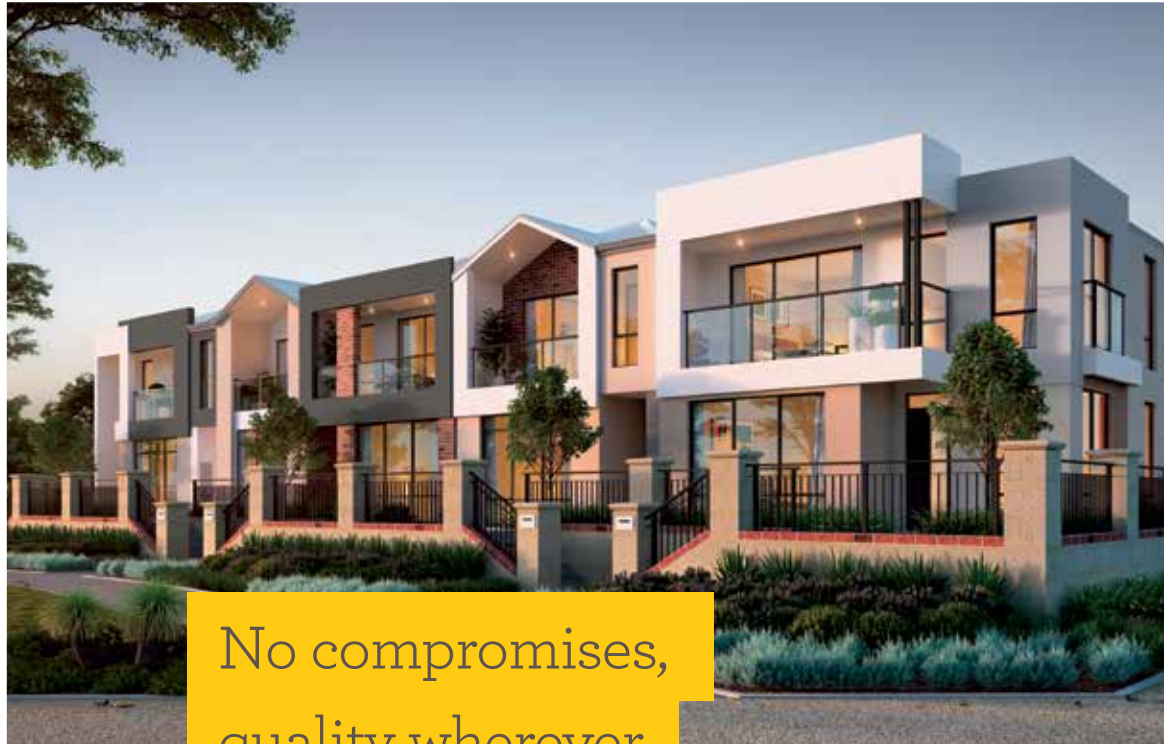

Crispy Skin Lemon Chicken & Potatoes

Ingredients

- 1kg chicken thigh cutlets, skin on
- 60g butter
- 500g baby potatoes
- 4 lemons, halved
- 1/2 cup fresh oregano sprigs, plus extra, to serve
- 4 garlic cloves, unpeeled
- 50ml (1 cup) chicken stock

Step 1: Preheat oven to 180C/160C fan forced. Pat the chicken skin dry with paper towel and season.

Step 2: Melt half the butter in an ovenproof frying pan over medium-high heat. Add chicken, skin side down, and cook for 5 minutes or until golden. Turn and cook for a further 2 minutes. Transfer chicken to a plate. Add the potatoes to the pan. Cook, turning regularly, for 4-5 minutes or until golden. Transfer to a plate. Add 4 lemon halves, cut side down, to pan. Cook for 2-3 minutes, until caramelised. Transfer to a plate and reserve.

Step 3: Reduce heat to low. Squeeze juice from remaining lemon halves into pan and stir to deglaze. Add squeezed lemon halves, potatoes, oregano and garlic to the pan. Cook for 2 minutes. Remove pan from heat and add stock. Arrange chicken, skin side up, on top of potatoes, keeping the skin exposed. Bake for 25-30 minutes or until chicken is cooked through and potatoes are tender. Transfer chicken, potatoes and garlic to a plate. Cover to keep warm.

Step 4: Strain the liquid from the pan into a small saucepan. Discard solids. Bring to the boil over high heat. Cook for 10-15 minutes or until sauce reduces and thickens slightly. Stir in remaining butter until melted. Season. Drizzle sauce over the chicken and potatoes. Scatter with extra oregano and serve with reserved caramelised lemon.

JESS GREEN RAISES \$ 1000 FOR HEARTKIDS WA

Well done to Jess Green from HKY who competed in the HBF Run for a Reason and successfully raised over \$1000 for HeartKids WA! Jess is a local Banksia Grove agent and resident for the past 8 years with kids in local primary and secondary schools. Jess's next project is a charity walk in September called 2 Feet and a Heartbeat which also raises funds for HeartKids WA.

Not many people know Jess's daughter Eryn was born with two congenital heart defects – ventricular septal defect (commonly known as a hole in the heart) and the "less common and much more serious" interrupted aortic arch. It took months of operations and support from HeartKidsWA to ensure Eryn could enjoy her "fairly normal life".

Any future listings signed up and sold by Jess between now and December 2018 will receive a \$100 donation from her commission to either HeartKids WA or Cancer Council Relay for Life which she's participating in October in Joondalup. **Best of luck Jess!**

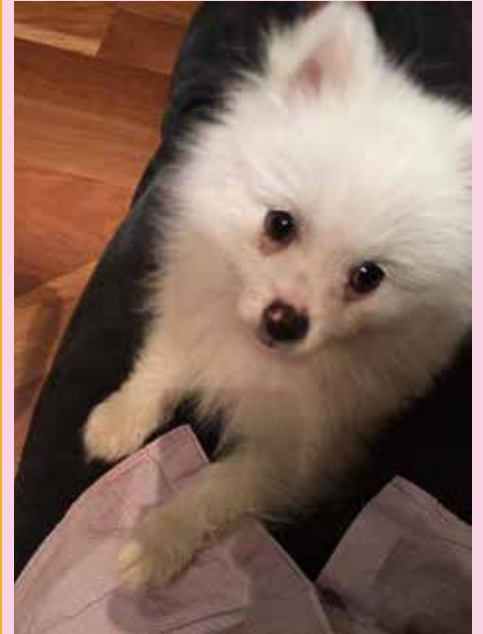
