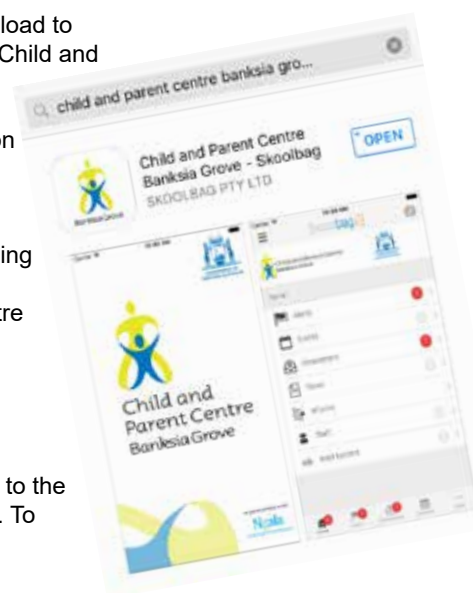

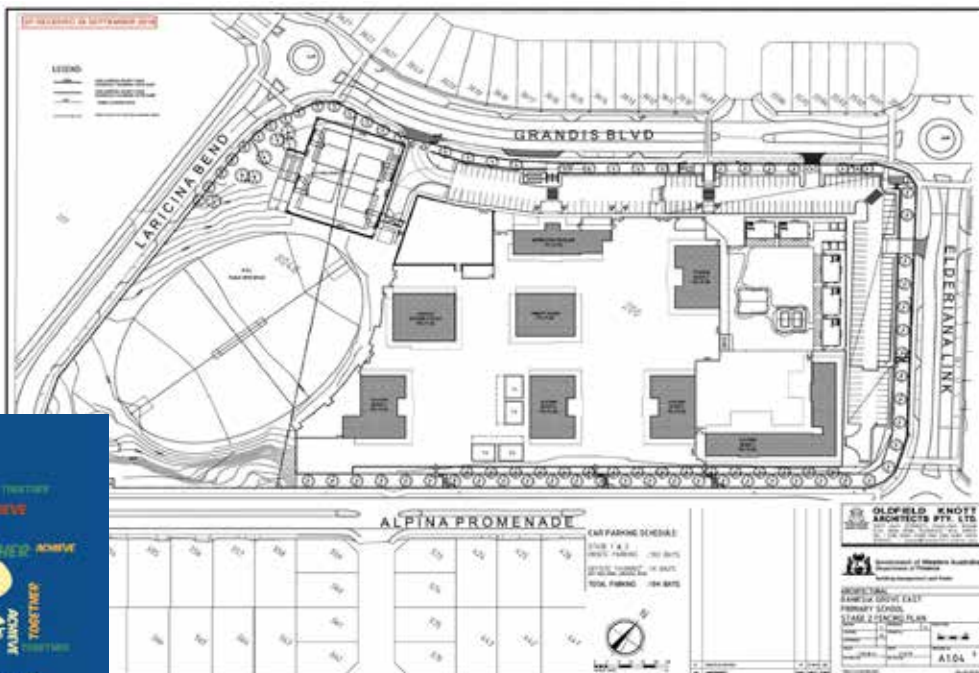

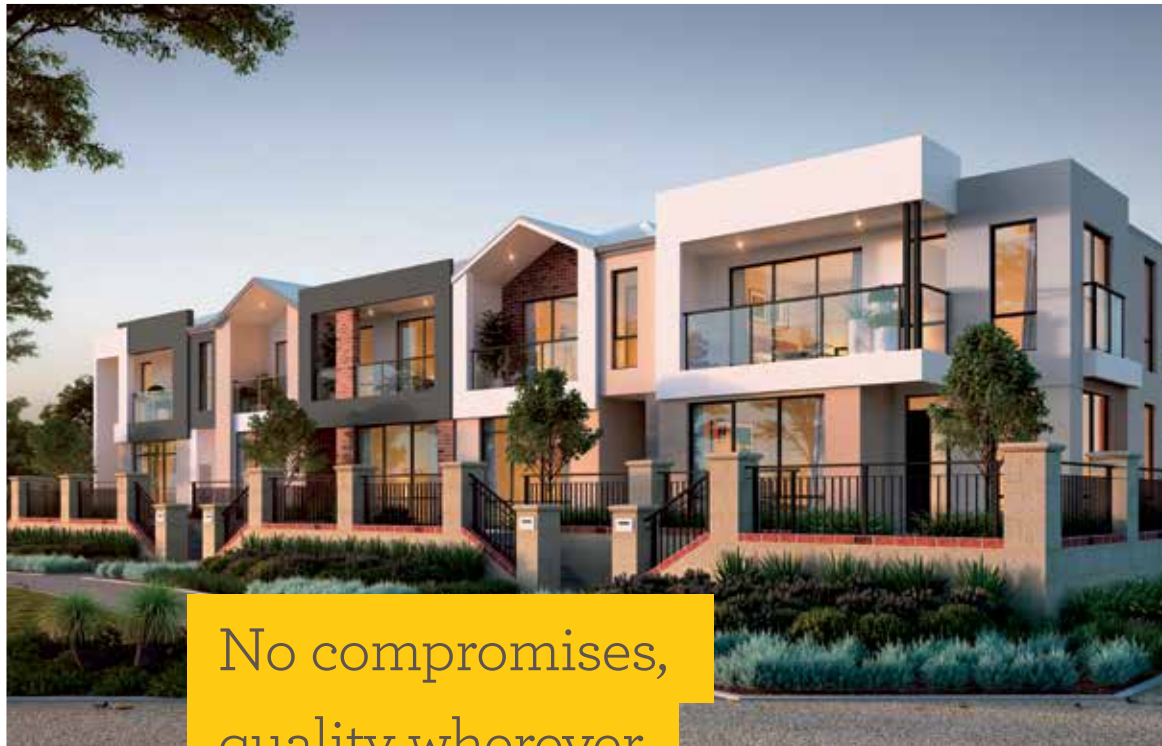

TRIED AND TESTED BY A GROOVY GRANNY!



Caramelised Beef Rice Paper Rolls

Ingredients

- 1 tablespoon peanut oil
- 2 large garlic cloves, finely chopped
- 350g beef mince
- 70g (1/3 cup) caster sugar
- 1 tablespoon fish sauce
- Ground white pepper
- 60g rice vermicelli noodles
- 12 round 22cm rice paper wrappers
- 100g (1 1/4 cups) rainbow coleslaw
- 24 fresh mint leaves, plus extra, to serve
- Sliced fresh red chilli, to serve
- Vietnamese dipping sauce, to serve

Step 1: Heat the oil in a wok over high heat. Add the garlic and stir-fry for 30 seconds or until aromatic. Add the mince and stir-fry, breaking up lumps with a wooden spoon, for 5 minutes or until it changes colour. Add the sugar and reduce heat to medium-low. Cook, stirring often, for 10 minutes or until beef is caramelised. Stir in the fish sauce and season with salt and white pepper. Set aside to cool to room temperature.

Step 2: Meanwhile, place the noodles in a heatproof bowl. Add enough boiling water to cover. Set aside for 15 minutes to soak. Drain. Use scissors to cut into smaller lengths. Set aside.

Step 3: Soak a rice paper wrapper in warm water for 10-20 seconds. Transfer to a clean tea towel to absorb excess water. Place a little of the noodles in the centre of the wrapper. Add about 1 tablespoon each of the mince and coleslaw. Top with 2 mint leaves. Fold in the ends and roll up to enclose filling. Place on a plate and cover with a slightly damp cloth to prevent drying out. Continue with remaining wrappers and fillings. Scatter with chilli and extra mint. Serve with the dipping sauce.

SKATEPARK & COMMUNITY CLUB ROOMS LAUNCH

SATURDAY 27 OCTOBER 2PM-7PM

The City of Wanneroo will be officially opening both the new Banksia Grove Skatepark and the new Grandis Park Pavilion Community Club Rooms (located next to Joseph Banks Secondary College) on Saturday 27 October from 2pm.

The \$600,000 skatepark was jointly funded by the City, Lotterywest and Banksia Grove Development. The \$3 million amenities building at Grandis Park Pavilion will include change rooms, a multi-purpose hall, kiosk, first aid room, storage spaces and sport floodlighting. The building was jointly funded by the City of Wanneroo and the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries.

To celebrate the launch of the skatepark a Freestyle Now competition will be held showcasing all disciplines including BMX, skateboard and scooter from 4pm to 7pm.

The openings event will also include food trucks, a community barbecue, giant garden games and community stalls.
