FREE FUN: Bouncy castle, dodgem cars, merry-go-round, face painting, giant slide, pony rides and animal nursery.

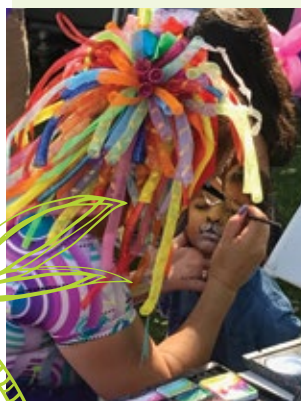
FREE ACTIVITIES: Kids crafts, balloon twisters, roving entertainers and magician.

The pedestrian activated traffic signals on Joondalup Drive by the entrance to Ghost Gum Boulevard are now operational. These signals are to assist with the safe passage of vulnerable road users across what is a busy, and high-speed road. The BGRA have been seeking the installation of these signals for many years, and to now have them in place is exciting. The BGRA would like to thank Rita Saffioti MLA for her assistance in getting these signals installed.

On the community appearance front, it is perhaps time for a reminder that in the City of Wanneroo, residents are responsible for maintenance of verges that adjoin their properties. This may include verges beyond a retaining wall or front fence, and for corner blocks, verges on both roadsides of your property. It is fair to say that there are plenty of verges around Banksia Grove at present that could do with some TLC, whether it be overgrown grass, weeds or bits of rubbish.

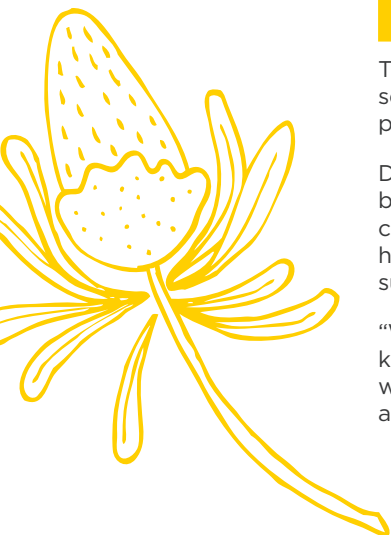

WHAT TO REPORT

Sometimes it can be confusing to know what to report and when to report it.

Below is a list of examples of suspicious behaviours; if you see similar activities occurring, we recommend that you need to call and report it to Police.

A person carrying property, such as electronic devices eg. laptops, ipads, mobile phones, stereo, office equipment, or a locked bike, at an unusual time or location.

Someone going door-to-door in an office building or residential area without the appropriate identification or a vehicle cruising the streets repeatedly. This person may be looking for an opportunity to steal unattended property from unsecured offices or homes.

Anyone forcing their way into a locked vehicle.

Transactions being held at a vehicle or a high volume of traffic going to and coming from a home on a daily basis.

One or more people sitting in a parked car checking out the area; they may be lookouts for a possible crime in progress, a burglary or robbery or planning a crime in the future.

A person showing unusual mental or physical symptoms; he or she may be injured, have been in an accident, be under the influence of illegal drugs or prescribed medications or need other medical or psychiatric help.

Unusual noises: alarms, gunshots, yelling, fighting sounds, dogs barking incessantly.

WHO TO REPORT IT TO

1. Crime Stoppers 1800 333 000 www.crimestopperswa.com.au

To report any information about suspicious behaviour or activity either current or from the past. Name, address and phone number of the caller are not required.

2. Local Police 131 444

For non urgent Police attendance which may include - antisocial behaviour, home burglary or motor vehicle theft.

3. 000

For any situation where life or serious injury is threatened. When a serious crime is in progress, being witnessed or just committed.

WHAT IF I AM WRONG

If there are no linkages or there isn't enough information for action to be taken the report will be "filed for intelligence".

This means that no action can be taken until a linkage or more information implicating the person is received.

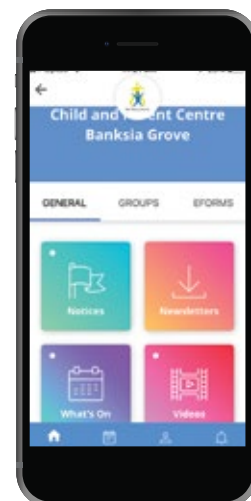
