Whilst helping make a great contribution toward cleaning up the environment, the Green Grover's main purpose is for members to get together to connect, catch up, share, support each other and have a laugh. Tania Belton, whose idea it was to start the group, said it was initially a way for people to volunteer locally and do something for their community.

"The group has created friendships amongst people of all ages - including our kids, who previously didn't know each other. We love to chat, have a good gossip about our week and laugh at the most ridiculous things." said Tania.

Fellow Green Grover Kylie Jenner said her involvement in the group has helped her and her teenage daughter

to become "contributors rather than consumers" and that life lessons are being learnt just through the simple task of picking up rubbish.

Whilst Tania and Kylie say that it could be easy to get angry and despondent about thoughtless and inconsiderate actions or littering and dumping unwanted goods by some people, they would rather focus on the positive.

"We get personal reward for what we do" said Kylie, "but we also appreciate passers-by who honk their horns, give us a thumbs up, offer words of encouragement or even bring us bottles of water."

## BGRA CHAIRPERSON

The BGRA held its second meeting of the year in mid-May - the minutes are available on the Facebook page, or by emailing me on the address below. The minutes (as the meetings themselves do) give a good rundown on what the BGRA has been up to of late.

The remaining BGRA meeting dates for 2019 are July 29 (AGM), and October 21. They are both Mondays and are held at the Banksia Grove Community Centre starting at 7.30pm. We hope to see you there.

Construction of pedestrian activated traffic signals on Joondalup Drive, by the entrance to Ghost Gum Boulevard, is expected to be completed in August. These signals are to provide a signalised crossing point for pedestrians crossing Joondalup Drive who previously have had to judge vehicle distances and speeds to attempt a safe crossing. There has been a large element of risk involved in this for years, particularly for vulnerable road users, such as school children, parents with prams and the elderly. Please respect the road workers during the likely two-week installation, and importantly, to all pedestrians who cross in this section of Joondalup Drive, please make use of the traffic signals. The BGRA would like to thank Rita Saffioti MLA for her personal assistance in getting these signals installed, and also the City of Wanneroo.

# GOODSTART EARLY LEARNING FUND OPPORTUNITIES

The Banksia Grove Goodstart Early Learning Centre has the opportunity to provide support for eligible families to funding available through the Early Learning Fund.

The Early Learning Fund (ELF) provides support for children living in disadvantaged circumstances who would otherwise miss out on preschool/kindergarten in the years before school.



So, exactly how does ELF work? ELF ensures each qualifying child receives a minimum of two days per week, with dedicated support, in a Uniting or Goodstart centre. This support includes transport in some locations.

ELF is built on mutual obligation and allows our experienced educators to work with families by developing an Education and Well Being Plan for each child, providing regular reviews and connections to other support services as required such as speech pathology.

In return, ELF families make a co-contribution of \$5 per day and ensure their child attends regularly and is immunised.

#### Australian Gymnastics Championships

Year 7 Joseph Banks Secondary College student Molly Van Roon competed in the Australian

Gymnastics Championships in Melbourne in May where she was 5th overall and received a bronze medal for Western Australia in the team tumbling event. She also competed in double mini trampoline and was 25th overall.


Year 9 Joseph Banks Secondary College student Jorja Carberry trains at High Flyers, joined with other WA clubs to represent WA in the Australian Gymnastics Championships. Jorja represented WA for the third time this year. This year she competed in Individual Under 17, Level 6 Trampoline and finished 28th, this rank is Australia and New Zealand wide. She also teamed up with a Tasmanian competitor of the same level to compete in synchronized Under 17, Level 6 Trampoline. They met for the first time about an hour before competing and worked well together, finishing in 15th place overall.

## BANKSIA GROVE PS BUILDING A BETTER START

Working hard to enable children having a better start to their schooling is at the forefront of the partnership between Banksia Grove Primary, Ngala and Goodstart Early Learning. Recently staff from all three agencies met to review the data from the latest Australian Early Development Census.

Every three years, the Census takes a snapshot of the health and well-being of children entering formal schooling. It provides localised information about the development of the children and identifies possible deficiencies. This information allows agencies to target resources and activities in order to improve children's health and well-being.

Having such a strong partnership in Banksia Grove means that we can combine resources and address children's needs from birth to six. The sharing of ideas also means that activities are much richer and more targeted at specific outcomes.



## GRANDIS PRIMARY SCHOOL MAKING RAPID PROGRESS

Construction of the Stage 2 buildings at Grandis Primary School is progressing well. Stage 2 of the school will open for students in Kindergarten to Year 6 on day one of the 2020 school year. The school will provide state of the art learning facilities for its students including 5 Learning Blocks, purpose built Art & Craft room, Music Room, Library, Covered Assembly Area, Canteen, basketball courts and oval. It has been exciting to watch the buildings as they are constructed.

As well as seeing buildings develop, our community has engaged positively with the school through the establishment of its foundation School

Board and P&C Association. These community groups play an important role in ensuring the community has input to our school with the School Board working to develop direction and policy while the P&C works to support us through fundraising as well as communication, community interaction and relationship building.

This Term our School Board has created a Dress Code and made decisions about our Faction uniform as well as our Faction names while our P&C has planned some fundraising activities which include Entertainment Books and a cake stall.

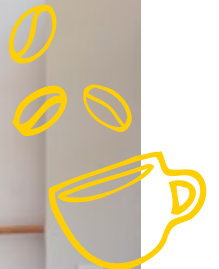

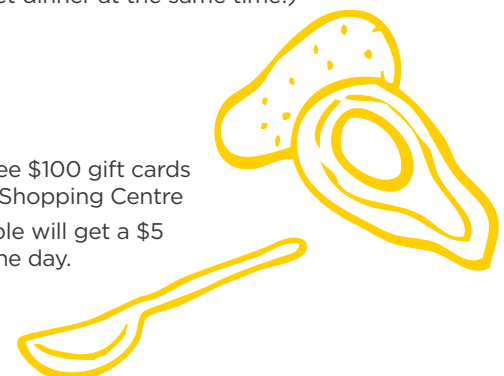

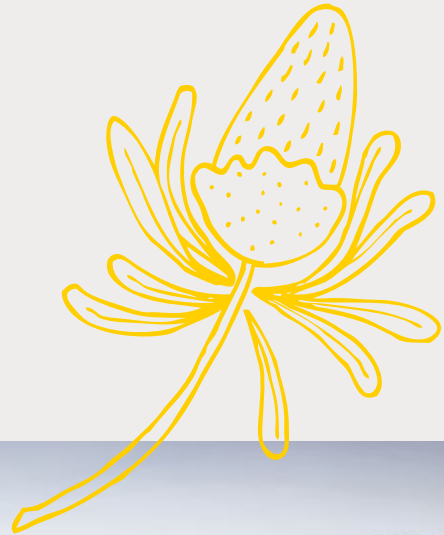

## What is Neighbourhood Watch?

Neighbourhood Watch is a program where neighbours unite and work together.

We believe that a safe, connected neighbourhood is one where neighbours know each other, communicate with each other, and are familiar with their local environment. Where neighbours take the time to know what is going on around them, look out for and care about their community.

If something is out of the ordinary then make a report to WA Police Force and share the information with your neighbours.

No one knows more about what is going on in a neighbourhood than those that live there.



## How it Works

By bringing people together with a common purpose to create a safe, connected and friendly neighbourhood.

## Become Involved

1. Get to know your neighbours. Introduce yourselves with our Knock Knock cards, knock on their door or a simple wave and a hello is a good start. Use our resources to introduce the idea of creating a local Neighbourhood Watch network.
2. Swap contact information or set up a communication network on a social media application.
3. Sign up to a WA Police Force Facebook page or Twitter account to stay informed of what is happening in your community.
4. Make your home and apartment safer and less inviting for would be intruders. Use our safety checklist as a guide.
5. Contact Neighbourhood Watch WA for resources to share with your neighbours.
6. Follow our crime prevention tips opposite.

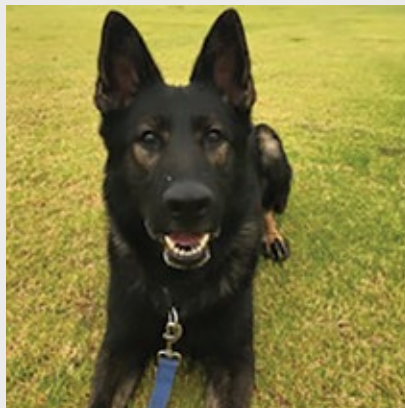

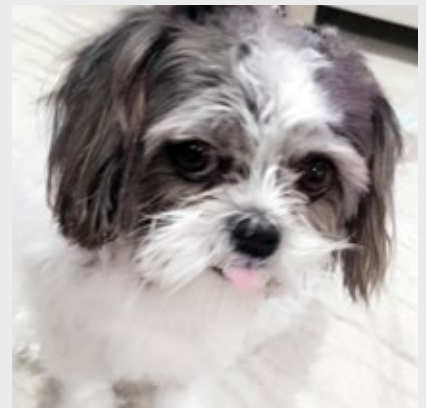
