BANKSIA GROVE WINS MASTERPLAN COMMUNITY AWARD

The long term vision for Banksia Grove was recently recognised at the Urban Development Institute of Australia (UDIA) awards evening when the estate was judged as Western Australia's best Master-planned Development Community (2020).

In accepting the award, Brendan Acott – Managing Director of LWP, the developers of Banksia Grove in partnership with the WA Government's Department of Communities, highlighted the thriving town centre, range of community facilities, pre-school, primary and secondary schools, recreation and public open spaces and large portions of retained native bushland – such as Discovery Park, as features of the development that the judging panel recognised.

"Since 2005, we have set out to develop a self-sufficient, new neighbourhood that would provide a lifestyle where residents could be part of a close knit community and which enabled people to access employment opportunities in the local area." Mr Acott said.

"Planning a development for 3700 dwellings requires a lot of consideration and liaison with all levels of government, interest groups and organisations," said Brendan. "The judges acknowledged that Banksia Grove has delivered a successful Community Development plan that has involved and engaged residents since the beginning of the project, offered a range of housing options that cater for a wide

range of buyers at various stages of their lives and has ensured the timely provision of community facilities as the estate has grown."

Thanks to everyone who has been part of the Banksia Grove journey over the years and particularly to the community members who have actively contributed to making the suburb the great place that it is today.



BGRA UPDATE MICHAEL RICHARDS, BGRA CHAIRPERSON

I hope everyone is well, and that your family and friends are too. It has been an interesting, and at times difficult, year since the last edition of the Buzz but we have a lot to be thankful for here in Banksia Grove and W.A in general, as we look around the world.

The BGRA held its first general meeting of 2021 on February 15, and the minutes from that meeting has recently been published on the BGRA Facebook page. The next meeting will be held on May 10 at the Banksia Grove Community Centre starting at 7.30pm.

This month sees the State Election. I looked back at my notes from the Buzz just before the last State Election in 2017, where I said that the "BGRA will be looking to work closely with the successful candidate over the next four years." I think it is important to recognise the contribution that we received from two members of parliament during those four years. As of this 2021 election Banksia Grove will be in the District of Wanneroo, whereas for the last four years it has been in the District of West Swan. The boundary between the two Districts for the last four years was Pinjar Road, and this proved beneficial to Banksia Grove in that as above we were in effect served by two MLAs - Rita Saffioti (West Swan) and Sabine Winton (Wanneroo). With Rita's Ministerial workload, Sabine was able to deputise on many occasions, and both MLAs and the BGRA formed a close working relationship that ensured the completion of not only 2017 election commitments for Banksia Grove, but the delivery of additional projects and funding, as well as day to day support for the community. Highlights for the community included the opening of Grandis Primary School, the Wanneroo Road / Joondalup Drive interchange, development of Joseph Banks Secondary College (with further infrastructure expansion underway), signalised pedestrian crossing at the shopping centre and a \$200,000 grant for a dog park to the City which has since opened at Edgar Griffiths Park in Wanneroo.

The BGRA congratulates Rita and Sabine on their reelection and we look forward to working with them over the next four years. The upgrade of Flynn Drive is one project in particular that the BGRA has campaigned for over recent years, and anticipate the project commencing within the next 12 months and the improved safety that will result when the project is completed.

MURAL

Banksia Grove has been wrapped in stunning images of Australia's natural wildlife thanks to the installation of two massive murals on the shopping centre precinct off Pinjar Road.

Artist Phil Doncon drew inspiration from the Banksia Woodlands and Lake Joondalup to create the 30 metre by 6 metre installations, injecting a huge splash of colour into the area.

"I've been driving up and down through those woodlands from Perth to Geraldton all the time," Phil said in a recent interview. The works are a celebration of the local flora and fauna around the area, featuring an array of birdlife, emus, kangaroos and of course, banksias.

Phil said it was really awesome to have the opportunity to bring some art and colour into a public space at such scale. "It's really something to work at such a scale, with the finished paintings towering over you, it's certainly a unique way to experience art," he said.

What's happening in Banksia Grove's Schools

GRANDIS PRIMARY SCHOOL UPDATE

Grandis Primary School is excited in 2021 to be in its third year of operation as provides for students from Kindergarten to Year Six. Our enrolment numbers have continued to climb with 100 Kindergarten students starting this year and an overall student population of just over 460.

Our school has established itself as a strong learning community with a mission to "...assist students to develop knowledge, skills and behaviour essential for life." We have established four core behaviour expectations for our community which include:

- We are Kind
- We are Responsible
- We are Respectful
- We are Learners

In 2021 the school will continue to embed these behaviour expectations and signage is displayed all around the school. and students have created some mascots based on the sculptures that are installed at the school. We have established a very active P&C as well as a School Board which works to promote and support the school. At the start of 2021 the P&C employed a canteen manager and opened the school canteen for two days per week. The canteen has been named 'Mereny Café' based on the Nyoongah word for 'food'.



Opening of the canteen was supported greatly

in 2020 with a grant from Banksia Grove Development Group of \$2000. An additional \$2500 was given to our new community playgroup which started in 2020.

ST JOHN PAUL II SCHOOL UPDATE

It wasn't the start to the school year that St John Paul II students were expecting - an extra week of holidays followed by a week of guessing which school staff were behind the masks! Thankfully students were exempt from wearing masks and adjusted well to the unusual start, then settled in nicely for the year ahead. It was an exciting time for students to be back at school reconnecting with friends, whilst parents were happy knowing their children were back in their school routine.

The wonderful late summer weather Perth experienced coincided perfectly with school swimming lessons. Students from Years 1 to 6 travelled to Aquamotion in Wanneroo to take part in their annual swimming lessons over 2 weeks. This was a wonderful opportunity to practice a vital life skill and also have fun in the water with friends!

Students had another reason to be excited by the start of this school year after discovering new playground additions to keep them entertained! Thanks to a Federal Government grant and supported with a P&F contribution, a new climbing structure was installed next to the school oval. Already a huge success and popular with the students, there will be hours of fun in the years ahead as children explore the 'Eagles Lair'. A small yacht hull was also added, a great new feature creating endless imaginative and creative sea adventure based play opportunities.

SETTING A STANDARD AT JOSEPH BANKS SECONDARY COLLEGE

The future is bright at Joseph Banks Secondary College. In 2020 the school was acknowledged as the most improved public school in Western Australia, with a Median ATAR of 74.95. We also had 100% of our Year 12s complete a Certificate II or higher and/ or achieved an ATAR of 55 and above. This year our aim is to ensure that all students achieve their full potential and are extremely competitive in their pathway postschool. By the end of Year 12 our students will have achieved:

- A minimum of 20 "C" grades
- At least one Certificate (ASOF)
- 65% in every assessment, including semesterized exams
- High levels of wellbeing through identifying a mentor and setting achievable goals.
